**5 Treasurers Report**

The following report was presented by Annette:

Our clinic fees will be staying the same this year, as we have been lucky enough to keep trainer and arena hire costs the same.

These are great value at £18.50 per person per clinic with 3/4 sharing 1 hour or £20 with 2 sharing 45 minutes.

Rosettes as you all know everyone likes a pretty ribbon. Costs of rosettes this year has been £690.00

Clothing this year has been our most expensive purchase coming in at £1012.00, we have not only had team clothing made we have also had anniversary hoodies and hats. We still have some available in stock if you would like to have a look.

Calendars were also purchased costing £246, we have managed to sell quite a few but have a handful left, these are available still at a discounted price of £5.

Money raised from raffles, bingo and team dressage really helps towards the following:

Cheaper clinics for members, this year we have more planned.

We continue to look after our lovely helpers and chef d'equipes at qualifiers and championships.

When we send a team of 3 to a competition, we always keep costs for the member the same as when it is a team of 4, this means that the club swallows this cost, we find this keeps it all fair for everyone.

This year the club has also gifted some prizes, ie membership and clinics to the fantastic raffles we have had.

Team dressage was a great success and we were lucky that Amanda Shenton secured fab prizes and sponsors. Donations also came in to help towards members cost for horse trials

Qualifier dates are now being published for this year. For any invitations received for the championships, you need to ensure that your membership is still valid otherwise the qualification will become void.

Rule change coming into force for summer dressage qualifier, from June onwards you can ride in more than one team so long as you are riding at different levels, for example you can ride in one team at Intro and the other team at Prelim, or one team at Prelim and the other team at Novice level.
